Failure to comply may result in injury or accidents. For repair assistance, please contact the dealer where the product was purchased.

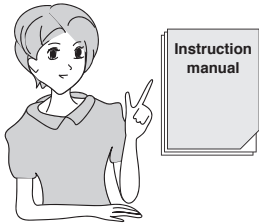

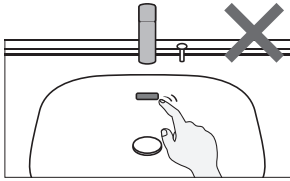
**Water supply and drainage work should only be carried out by individuals who are qualified and comply with relevant laws and regulations.**

Be aware that unexpected injuries may occur.

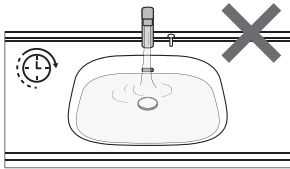
**Ensure proper installation of built-in electrical products, water faucets, etc. by following the instructions in the respective manuals and the indications on the main unit.**

There is a risk of injury from sharp edges or internal protrusions.

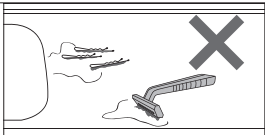


**Do not leave hot or cold water running unattended.**  
Water overflowing onto the floor can cause serious damage.

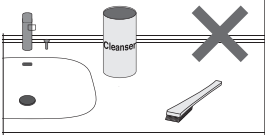


2 USAGE PRECAUTIONS (must be adhered to)

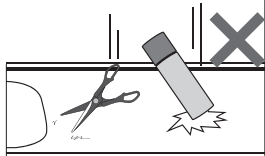
**Do not leave wet metal items like hairpins or razor blades on the counter or bowl.**  
They may leave rust stains that cannot be removed.



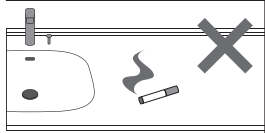
**Avoid using abrasive cleaners or cleaning tools with abrasive particles (like non-woven pads or scrubbers).**  
These can scratch the surface and cause damage to the counter or bowl.



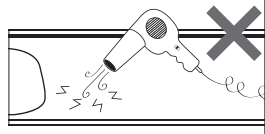
**Do not subject it to strong impacts.**  
Dropping sharp or heavy objects on the counter or bowl can cause scratches, deformation, or cracks, and may lead to injury.



**Do not place or hold burning items (like cigarettes or matches) on or near the counter or bowl.**  
This may damage or scorch the surface.



**Do not apply heat directly to the counter surface (such as from a hair dryer).**  
This may cause deformation or discoloration.



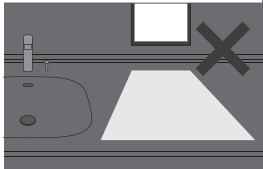
**Do not use or keep solid or powdered chlorine cleaners, bleach, or slime removers nearby.**  
Gases generated by reacting with water or humidity may corrode or damage stainless steel and rubber parts. ※ Be sure to store them properly.



**Do not use organic solvents, strong acidic or alkaline cleaners, or toilet cleaners.**  
These may damage drain fittings and cause leaks or discoloration.

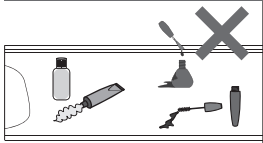
**Avoid pouring hot water into the bowl.**  
It may deform or damage the drain fittings, leading to water leakage.

**Do not splash water onto the counter backsplash.**  
Water may spill over and wet the wall or floor.

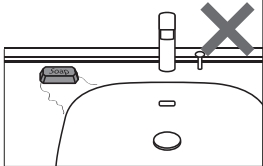


**Avoid direct exposure to sunlight.**  
If the area receives constant sunlight, always block it with curtains or similar. Do not direct spotlights or UV sterilizers onto it, as this may lead to discoloration or deformation.

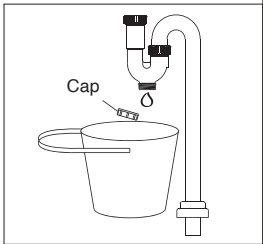
**Wipe off any cosmetics or chemicals like hair dye or nail polish remover immediately with neutral detergent.**  
They may cause discoloration or deformation.



**Avoid placing soap directly on the counter or bowl. Be sure to use a soap dish.**  
Prolonged direct contact may lead to discoloration.



**When removing the U-pipe cap during cleaning, use a bucket to catch the water.**  
There is a risk of leakage.

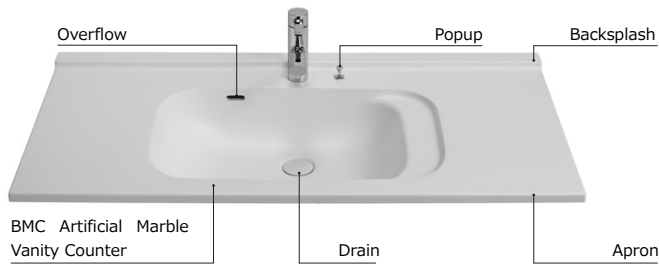


**When using chlorine-based cleaners in the wash basin or drain, thoroughly rinse with plenty of water afterward to remove any cleaner residue.**  
Residual cleaner may damage the basin or pipes and lead to leaks.

**Remove dropped items before running water.**  
They may clog the drain and cause overflow.

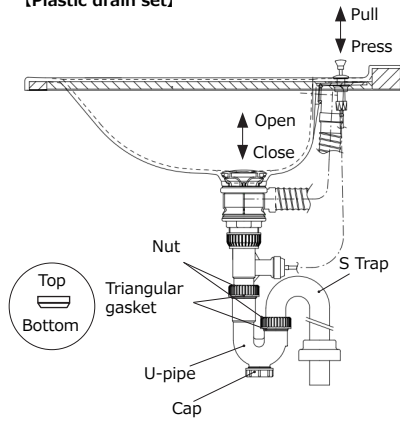

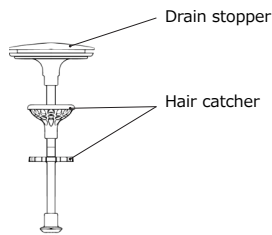


※Pressing or pulling the pop-up knob will open or close the drain stopper.

## 2 steps of care

#### ①Wipe with water



#### ②Wipe dry



Frequency	Maintenance method
Daily basis	<p><b>[Regular Care]</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wipe thoroughly with damp cloth.</li> <li>Wipe dry with soft cloth.</li> </ol> <p><b>Note :</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If stains are left long, they become sticky and hard to remove.</li> <li>Please take good care of the product.</li> </ul> <p><b>[In case of stubborn stains]</b></p> <p>Please follow the steps below, one by one, until all stains are removed.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use kitchen neutral detergent and gently wipe away the stains with a soft cloth or sponge.</li> <li>Gently rub with a nylon scrubber (avoid excessive rubbing, which can cause excessive glossiness).</li> <li>If necessary, gently rub entire area with cream cleanser, avoiding excessive rubbing in one spot to avoid surface variations in glossiness.</li> </ol> <p><b>Note :</b> Make sure to rinse the surface with water to remove any detergent residue, and then wipe it dry with a cloth.</p> <p><b>[In case of minor scratches]</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If necessary, gently rub entire area with cream cleanser, avoiding excessive rubbing in one spot to avoid surface variations in glossiness.</li> <li>Rinse the surface to remove detergent residue, then wipe with dry cloth.</li> </ol> <p><b>[In case of deep scratches or chips]</b></p> <p>If there are deep scratches or chips, please contact the store of purchase. Repair may not be feasible depending on the severity of the damage.</p>

Frequency	Maintenance method
Daily basis	<p><b>[In case of oily stains]</b></p> <p>For oily stains such as permanent marker, nail polish, or tobacco tar, apply benzine or nail polish remover to tissue or gauze and wipe the stain.</p> <p><b>Note :</b> After cleaning, always rinse thoroughly with water to completely remove any cleaner, then wipe dry with a cloth.</p>
Once a week	<p><b>[Cleaning hair catcher]</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove the drain stopper and clean the hair catcher using a toothbrush or similar tool.</li> <li>After cleaning, insert the hair catcher carefully, making sure it is oriented correctly.</li> </ol>
Once a month	<p><b>[Water leakage inspection]</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If something is clogged inside the S-trap.           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove the S-trap cap and clear any blockage. Since water is retained inside the trap, use a bucket to catch it when removing the cap.</li> <li>Remove the U-pipe cap and clear any blockage. Since water is retained inside the trap, use a bucket to catch it when removing the U-pipe cap.</li> </ul> </li> <li>If dirt or hair is accumulated in the drain hair catcher. Remove the hair catcher and clear away any collected dirt or hair.</li> </ol> <p><b>Note :</b> After any cleaning, rinse thoroughly with water to completely remove any detergent, then wipe dry with a cloth.</p>
