1 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS (must be adhered to)

Prohibited Do not sit on or use the washbasin as a step stool.
This may cause slipping, falling, or injury. It may also deform or break the washbasin.



Prohibited Do not self-disassemble, repair, or modify the product.
Failure to comply may result in injury or accidents. For repair assistance, please contact the dealer where the product was purchased.




Caution Small children or individuals requiring assistance using this product should be accompanied by a caregiver.

Even for small parts, request repairs promptly. Leaving them as is may lead to unexpected accidents, such as injuries or accidental swallowing.


Caution Ensure proper installation of built-in electrical products, water faucets, etc. by following the instructions in the respective manuals and the indications on the main unit.

You may get injured by the edges or internal protrusions.




Caution Do not leave water running unattended.
Overflowing water onto the floor can lead to severe damage.




2 USAGE PRECAUTIONS (must be adhered to)


Prohibited Do not leave wet metal items such as hairpins or razor blades in the washbasin.
They may leave rust stains that cannot be removed.




Prohibited Avoid using abrasive cleaners or cleaning tools with abrasive particles (like non-woven pads or scrubbers).
These can scratch the surface and cause damage to the washbasin.




Prohibited Do not subject it to strong impacts.
Dropping sharp or heavy objects on the washbasin can cause scratches, deformation, or cracks, and may lead to injury.



Prohibited Do not use or keep solid or powdered chlorine cleaners, bleach, or slime removers nearby.
Gases generated by reacting with water or humidity may corrode or damage stainless steel and rubber parts. ※Be sure to store them properly.



Prohibited Do not place or bring lit items like cigarettes or matches near the washbasin.
It may cause damage or burn marks.




Prohibited Do not expose the product directly to heat from devices like hairdryers.
This may cause warping or discoloration.


Prohibited Do not use organic solvents, strong acids and alkaline detergents, toilet cleaners.
It may damage drain plug, causing leaks, discoloration, breakage, surface deterioration.

Prohibited Do not pour boiling water into the washbasin.
It may deform or damage the drain fittings, leading to water leakage.


Caution Avoid direct exposure to sunlight.
Always use curtains or similar coverings in areas that receive constant direct sunlight. Also, do not expose to spot lighting or germicidal lamps directly, as this may cause discoloration and deformation.




Caution If cosmetics, nail polish remover, nail polish, cleansing foam, mouthwash, toothpaste, hair dye, or hair color gets on the surface, wipe it off immediately with a sponge or soft cloth dampened with a neutral detergent.
It may cause discoloration or deformation.



Practice Do not place soap directly on the washbasin. Always use a soap dish.
Prolonged direct contact may lead to discoloration.



Practice When removing the U-pipe cap during cleaning, use a bucket to catch the water.
There is a risk of leakage.




Practice If chlorine-based detergent is used in the washbasin or poured into the drain, flush the washbasin and pipes with a large amount of water afterward to remove any remaining detergent.
It may damage the washbasin or drainage pipes and cause water leakage.

Practice Remove dropped items before running water.
They may clog the drain and cause overflow.




BMC artificial marble washbasin Drain

■ Care instructions

To maintain the beauty of the product, diligent care is important.

2 steps of care

① Wipe with water



② Wipe dry



Time	Maintenance method
Daily	<p>[Regular Care]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Wipe thoroughly with damp cloth. Wipe dry with soft cloth. <p>Note:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If stains are left long, they become sticky and hard to remove. Please take good care of the product. <p>[In case of stubborn stains]</p> <p>Please follow the steps below, one by one, until all stains are removed.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Use kitchen neutral detergent and gently wipe away the stains with a soft cloth or sponge. Gently rub with a nylon scrubber (avoid excessive rubbing, which can cause excessive glossiness). If necessary, gently rub entire area with cream cleanser, avoiding excessive rubbing in one spot to avoid surface variations in glossiness. <p>Note: Make sure to rinse the surface with water to remove any detergent residue, and then wipe it dry with clothes.</p> <p>[In case of minor scratches]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> If necessary, gently rub entire area with cream cleanser, avoiding excessive rubbing in one spot to avoid surface variations in glossiness. Rinse the surface to remove detergent residue, then wipe with dry cloth. <p>[In case of deep scratches or chips]</p> <p>If there are deep scratches or chips, please contact the store of purchase. Repair may not be feasible depending on the severity of the damage.</p>

Time	Maintenance method
Daily	<p>[In case of oily stains]</p> <p>Wipe off oily stains such as permanent marker, nail polish, and cigarette tar with a tissue or gauze soaked in alcohol, benzene, or nail polish remover.</p> <p>Note: In either cases, rinse with water to completely remove detergent residue, then wipe with dry cloth.</p>
Once a week	<p>[Cleaning hair catcher]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Remove the drain stopper and clean the hair catcher using a toothbrush or similar tool. After cleaning, insert the hair catcher carefully, making sure it is oriented correctly.
Once a month	<p>[Water leakage inspection]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> If something is clogged inside the S-trap. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Remove the S-trap cap and clear any blockage. Since water is retained inside the trap, use a bucket to catch it when removing the cap. ■ Remove the U-pipe cap and clear any blockage. Since water is retained inside the trap, use a bucket to catch it when removing the U-pipe cap. If dirt or hair is accumulated in the drain hair catcher. Remove the hair catcher and clear away any collected dirt or hair. <p>Note: After any cleaning, rinse thoroughly with water to completely remove any detergent, then wipe dry with a cloth.</p>
