Failure to comply may result in injury or accidents. For repair assistance, please contact the dealer where the product was purchased.

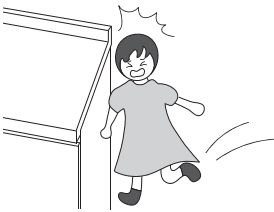


Do not get on the counter.
Such actions can potentially cause damage to the counter or result in injury.

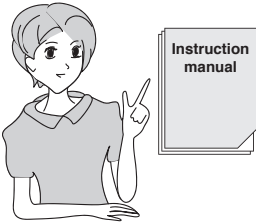


CAUTION

Improper installation can lead to unexpected accidents or malfunctions.



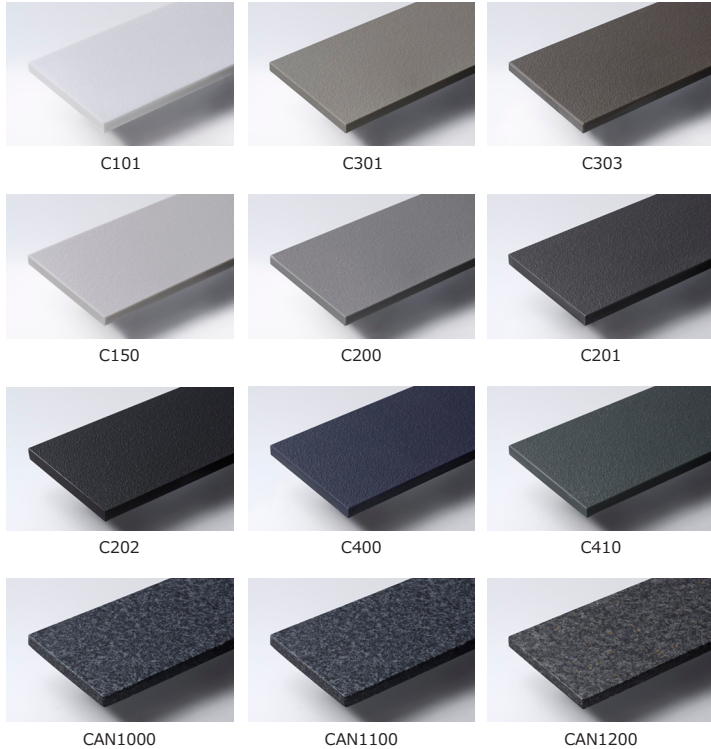
If you suspect a malfunction, please do not continue to use it as it is.

2 USAGE PRECAUTIONS (must be adhered to)

Do not allow direct flame to approach the counter. When using wide-bottomed pots or large frying pans, ensure that the fire does not protrude. There is a risk of flames spreading around and scorching the countertop.	
Do not scrub the surface with stainless steel scrubber or powdered cleaners. This may cause scratches or alter the surface's shine.	
Do not drag cooking utensils. Dragging pots, large dishes, and similar items on the counter may scratch the surface.	
Use a trivet. Placing hot items like frying pans, earthen pots, or boiling kettles directly on the same spot on the counter for extended periods can cause discoloration or cracking.	
Wipe off spills immediately. Clean up stains from condiments (soy sauce, vinegar, etc.), dark-colored foods (kimchi, curry, coffee, etc.), or boil-overs right away. If left for a long time, stains may become difficult to remove or cause discoloration.	
Do not use without cutting board. Using knives or other similar sharp tools directly on the counter may cause scratches on the surface.	

Do not subject it to strong impacts. Dropping sharp or heavy objects on the counter surface can cause scratches, deformation, or cracks for the counter, and may also lead to injury.	
Do not use strong acidic or alkaline detergents, or bleach. These can cause deterioration or discoloration.	
Do not get on the joint, place heavy objects on it, or subject it to strong impacts from above. This can cause warping, distortion, cracking at the joints, and rippling of the surface.	
Never leave wet metal products on the counter. Do not leave wet metal items like knives, cans, or pans for extended periods, as they can cause rust stains that are hard to remove.	
Wipe off water droplets from the front of the counter promptly. Leaving them dropping can stain and discolor cabinet doors.	
Avoid direct exposure to sunlight. Always use curtains or similar coverings in areas that receive constant direct sunlight. Also, do not expose to spot lighting or germicidal lamps directly, as this may cause discoloration and deformation.

■ Care instructions

To maintain the beauty of the surface, diligent care is important.

2 steps of care

① Wipe with water



② Wipe dry



Level of dirt or scratches	Maintenance method
[Daily basis]	1. Wipe thoroughly with damp cloth. 2. Wipe dry with soft cloth. Note : ・ If stains are left long, they become sticky and hard to remove. ・ Please take good care of the product.
[Stubborn stains]	Please follow the steps below. If the stain cannot be removed at each step, proceed to the next step. 1. Apply neutral detergent (for kitchen use) to a soft cloth or sponge and wipe away the dirt. 2. Place a cloth, such as gauze, soaked in neutral detergent on the stained area for a while (about 5 minutes), then wipe it off. 3. Wipe with a chlorine-based bleach, such as kitchen bleach. 4. Place a cloth, such as gauze, soaked in chlorine-based bleach, such as kitchen bleach, on the stained area for a while (about 5 minutes), then wipe it off. 5. If the stain persists, repeat step 4. Note: Always rinse with water at the end to completely remove the detergent, and wipe with a dry cloth.

Level of dirt or scratches	Maintenance method
[Oily stains]	Please follow the steps below. If the stain cannot be removed at each step, proceed to the next step. 1. Wipe with solvents such as alcohol, thinner, or benzene. 2. Place a cloth, such as gauze, soaked in the solvent on the stained area for a while (about 5 minutes), then wipe it off. 3. Wipe with chlorine-based bleach, such as kitchen bleach. 4. Place a cloth, such as gauze, soaked in chlorine-based bleach, such as kitchen bleach, on the stained area for a while (about 5 minutes), then wipe it off. 5. If the stain persists, repeat step 4. Note: Always rinse with water at the end to completely remove the detergent, and wipe with a dry cloth.
[Minor scratches]	1. Clean the scratched area and its surroundings with neutral detergent to remove dirt. 2. Rinse the cleaned area with water to completely remove the detergent. 3. Ensure thorough drying as leaving moisture may cause unevenness. 4. Soak a clean cloth in separately sold "ULTRA LIQUID" and apply it to the entire countertop. 5. Allow "ULTRA LIQUID" to penetrate for about 5 minutes. However, if the applied amount is small and begins to dry, wipe it off before it dries. Once dried, it becomes difficult to wipe off, leading to uneven application. 6. Using a new cloth, wipe the entire surface with "ULTRA LIQUID". 7. If scratches are still noticeable, repeat steps 4-6. 8. After application, it will dry in about 1 hour, but avoid contact with water for approximately 24 hours.
